- e. Improvements of church grounds:
 - i. Trees: the church hired a company to remove and trim trees around the church building, church house, and parking lots. You may have noticed how much open our grounds are!
 - ii. Fence: the wooden fence bordering our northern parking lot is looking like new following a thorough power-washing. Thanks to the congregants who took the time to do this!
- f. **Ongoing maintenance**: there remain projects to be completed around and outside the church: repaving the parking lots, finishing the Sunday School room renovations, repairing the inner security door to the church, and ongoing renovations to the church house.
